
5 THEMES OF GEOGRAPHY



1) LOCATION is the position of a place on the Earth's surface. In other words,

Where you are on the Earth.

Two types:

1) Absolute Location – uses latitude and longitude

2) Relative Location – giving your location in relation to other places

2) PLACE is an area defined by everything in it. In other words, what is it like there? A place is defined by its human and physical characteristics.

3) HUMAN-ENVIRONMENT interaction looks at the relationship
between people and their environment (surroundings).
 Adapting to one's environment
 Modifying one's environment
4) Region is an area defined by certain <u>Similar</u> characteristics.
Again, those characteristics can be human or physical.
(also, cultural or natural)
Examples: <u>Clothing</u> , <u>language</u> , <u>religion</u> , <u>music</u> , <u>landforms</u> , <u>bodies</u> of climate, water
5) MOVEMENT refers to the way people, products,
and ideas move from one place to another.
Yes, we're talking transportation AND communication!
Give examples of both: <u>Vehicles, ships</u> , <u>Media (radio, tv, internet)</u> aircraft
